- Consent Agenda
- Soccer Field Situation – Kevin and Andy
 - Grass is greening, telephone poles are gone, goals are moved South, approaches to the gates need worked/fixed, McCardle may need to re-do the approaches, concrete approaches according to City/County, need to have soil tested, check well, check electrical, get goals rounded up using tractor/hay fork, can't let 60 days go by.

- Meet with 7th going to 8th for next year’s DC trip – please inform them on concessions, gate, etc.
