- Soccer Field Situation – Kevin and Andy
 - North field will have to be re-done because of silt. The middle field may need it, South field is uneven as well. Parking lot needs re-done again. The well needs repaired and then tested, there is some debris/trash that has settled on the fields. The electric panel needs replaced. The sprinkler system will have to be tested. Fields need re-graded and re-sodded
