Review & approve prior meeting's minutes

Committee Reports (5 minute time limit per chair)

Finance Report – \$61k in the bank,

Athletic Director/Marty Report – Ryan stepping down from Athletic Director position, Marty demonstrated disinfecting guns, make sure to fill out log of disinfecting, gym door, entrances, etc.

New items:

- Finalizing "Safe Return to Play" document for fall sports:
- Review items in question and vote on answers:
 - If a St. Pats player tests positive what is our protocol
 - **Players, team, coaches, all quarantine for 14 days. Need to communicate to Brenda & Stacy if it is a St. Pat's student or Parish member, Douglas County Health,**
 - Who all needs to fill out waiver? Who will be the keeper (Each chair/Ryan?) **Everyone, only 1 spectator per family/athlete, chairs to collect all waivers for their sport**
 - Are we able to purchase temp caddy's for volleyball and other indoor sports where we agreed anyone entering the building needs to have a temp taken? - **agreed**
 - Who are we allowing in building: Immediate household members only, 4 persons per player, no spectators? How do we keep track? – one spectator per athlete - - > **volunteer and spectator are different – if you are helping with scoreboard, temperature taking, etc, that doesn't count against the one spectator rule**
 - Should we record each person who enters the building for each game, along with their temperature - best practice for doing so?
 - Make signage for both outdoor and indoor sports (Carrie and Melissa to draft)? Social distancing guidelines, wear masks, stay in seats during game, no playing in hallway. Signs for gym flow in and out of gymnasium
- Possibly discuss making and selling sportswear t-shirts (maybe sweatshirts): - - > **not sold by SPAC – coaches**
- 8th grade concession stand & DC Trip – Kevin - - > **not doing concession or taking gate**

Chair Reports

- Microsoccer – Dates 9/12, 9/19, 9/26, 10/3, 10/10, & 10/17 – email sent about playing to all participants – about 70 signed up at this point – good on fields and equipment – need jerseys from Dan or from gym (~30)
 - Coaches to wear masks
- Teeball – **dugouts look nice, make a thank you card to sign for the Eagle Scout**
- Flag Fball – Sept 13 first games, **registration still open, numbers a touch lower**
- PAL Fball – Sept 12 first games, **no masks for players**
- PAL Vball – Sept 10 first games, **3 volunteers per game**
 - Approve COVID policies and procedures form
 - Volunteers (check-in tables, scoreboard, cleaning)
 - Approve team protocol for sick child/exposure
- CYSL Soccer – **need a few game balls and first aid kits, meeting tomorrow night**
- Cheerleading – need to add Alyson & Erin to invites/meeting minutes, are cheerleaders allowed at the football games? - - >
- PK-2nd Bball – Signup will start September 1st
- PAL Track – **Brian supports kids participating in sports**
- Baseball and softball – **field usage should be low this fall**
