**Family Faith Formation Minister:** One Wednesday per month with Family Faith Formation groups at St. Pat's, plus one more day per month off campus on a day/time chosen by the group. This ministry begins with you as the group catechist, and develops over time as you train and mentor parents to take turns teaching the group. You may choose to minister to 1, 2, 3 or 4 groups on one week, or multiple weeks. Volunteer credit is given towards your family's FF Registration Fee (sacrament preparation fees not included).

**Substitute Family Faith Formation Minister:** Be on call to take over for an absent FF Minister (catechist).

**7th/8th Grade Faith Formation Minister:** One Wednesday per month at the same time families are in their K-6th family group, this ministry consists of a team of approximately 10, under the direction of St. Pat's Youth Minister. All 7th and 8th grade youth of the parish are invited to attend, and will be in one large group with break-out small groups discussions and activities. Volunteer credit is given towards your family's FF Registration Fee (sacrament preparation fees not included).

**Daycare Volunteer:** One Wednesday per month, provide daycare for children too young to join their family in group sessions. Volunteer credit (partial) is given towards your family's FF Registration Fee (sacrament preparation fees not included).

**Office Volunteer:** One Wednesday per month, provide administrative and operational assistance during family group sessions. Volunteer credit (partial) is given towards your family's FF Registration Fee (sacrament preparation fees not included).

**Discipleship Mentor:** Mentors team (in pairs) to coordinate and attend community service experiences for Confirmation candidates. Mentors must attend a mentor training session, and must also comply with the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Policies. Volunteer credit (partial) is given towards your family's FF Registration Fee (sacrament preparation fees not included).

**Liturgy of the Word for Children Minister:** During designated weekend Masses, adult volunteers lead the celebration of the word by proclaiming the readings and leading the discussion that follows the Gospel. Ministries include one leader and two shepherds to assist. Assignments are on a rotation basis. Ministers must comply with the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Policies. LWC is part of the weekend Liturgy.

**Vacation Bible School Volunteer:** Volunteer positions include Bible story teller, craft/game/skit or snack coordinator, daycare volunteer, office volunteer. Volunteers must comply with the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Policies.
