Committee/Staff Updates

Faith Formation: Elizabeth Hansen provided an overview of current Faith Formation activities for all age groups, as well as a look at what is planned for summer programming and the 2023-2024 school year. Please contact the Parish office for a complete list of Faith Formation updates.

Rite of Confirmation will be celebrated the weekend of March 25, 26. Archbishop George Lucas will be in attendance.

New Parish Staff: (Fr. Tom) – No update at this time.

New School Staff: (Fr. Tom) – No update at this time.

Athletics: (Dan) The athletic committee has not met yet this calendar year. Update expected at the next PPC meeting.

School Advisory Board: (update provided by Fr. Tom) – The school board met on March 15th. It was reported that a greater percentage of St. Patrick's middle schoolers received scholarships to Catholic High Schools. There were also an increased number of students taking Catholic high school placement exams.

Finance Committee (John): Current Sunday Offering Update listed in the Parish bulletin reflects a budget shortfall. This issue will be discussed at the upcoming finance committee meeting. More information to follow.

Church update: (Fr. Tom) Groundbreaking ceremony for the new church is set for June 4th. More details to follow.

The church plans to go live in June of this year with a new development management software platform provided by Bloomerang. The platform will provide greater capabilities for development and fundraising segmentation.

Capital Campaign: A total of 768 households have pledged to support the capital campaign. There are a total of 27 self-identified volunteers that have indicated their intent to make a campaign pledge but have not yet done so. At present the campaign is \$244,616 short of goal. MCL has indicated that the \$30M does not include the cost of the rectory.

Pastoral Planning Committee: Completed proposal was submitted to the Archdiocese in November. Feedback is expected from the Archdiocese very soon. The committee continues to meet with St. John the Evangelist's (Valley) pastor and committee members to discuss logistical details on how best to serve all parishioners in this united Parish family.

Other Business / Announcements

Parish Elections: As parish elections approach, the council is asked to think of individuals that might consider running for a seat on the PPC. There are a few individuals that are no longer able to serve after this term, due to term-limits. Electronic voting will not be possible for this round of elections. It will remain an item for future PPC discussions.
