II. Review of minutes from the previous meeting:
 PPC Notes from April – approved.

III. Committee/Staff Updates

- Staff: (Fr. Tom)
 - Jim Greufe will be going to part-time beginning June 1st.
- Faith Formation:
 - Senior breakfast was held last weekend
 - 1st Eucharist was held over two weekends
 - Several retreats were held over the past few weeks for 1st and 7th grades.
 - Welcome retreats coming up: Women’s will be last weekend of June and Men’s will be last weekend of July
- School Advisory Board: (Brian)
 - Officer elections
 - Board members and their spouses had dinner at the rectory
 - A letter was sent to all school families asking them to contribute to the Parish since their tuition is subsidized by the church. 40% of school families do not contribute. It was met with mixed responses but has increased the number of families donating.
- Athletics: (Dan)
 - No report
- Finance Committee: (John)
 - School revenues are ahead of budget
 - General contributions are approximately \$450,000 behind budget
 - Total revenue approximately \$120,000 behind budget
 - Expenses are under budget by approximately \$100,000
 - Overall in a good position for being ¾ of the way through the fiscal year
- Home & School: (Nicole)
 - Last meeting of the year
 - Provided lunch to the local elementary school staff and teachers that were affected by the tornados
 - Staff appreciation week went well and they tried some new ideas that were well-received
- Men’s Club:
 - No updates

- Women of St. Pat's (WOSP): (Zach)
 - Spring retreat was rescheduled and will be June 14th for Mothers and school aged daughters
 - Diaper wrapping event will be held May 15th
 - Fr asked them to look into the Christ Child Society
 - New Member rally/social May 29th
- Pastoral Planning:
 - Fr Tom has invited St. John's for the Pet Rock concert in May and to have a picnic this summer to open the conversations up again between our parishes
 - A lunch was scheduled for staff from both parishes to meet this week but will be rescheduled for this summer

- Strategic Planning:
 - Sessions were cancelled due to the tornadoes and will be rescheduled for the summer.
- Tornado Recovery Update:
 - Over \$150,000 has been raised to help victims and over 300 volunteers
 - Fr Tom shared stories of the recovery efforts and aid that St. Pat's has been able to offer
- New Church:
 - Progress continues and is on schedule
 - Fr Tom shared some updates on the construction meetings
 - Plans to be in the new rectory in June
 - The Ramm family will help secure the stained glass windows, railings and floors from the original St. Patrick's church before it is demolished
- Security
 - Dan will schedule meeting with Fr Tom and Vicki to discuss further – this is in the works but hasn't been scheduled yet
- Parish Elections
 - Thank you to John Beacom for his two terms and Michelle Kiemy for serving. Welcome to Tracey Brown, Stan Kathol and continuing for a 2nd term, Deb Gustafson

- Zach brought up a question about a summer childcare/camp option for K-5th grades; it has been discussed in the past and will be revisited when the new campus is open and the current office space can be modified to accommodate.
- Discussion about St. John's subsidizing tuition at St. Patrick's school for their parish families; Finance committee will revisit the current policy and develop a consistent policy for any families who come from other parishes; currently 20 families (28 children) who are non-Catholic attend St. Patrick's school
