Parishioners were very receptive to having their presence at Mass when they first began.
 - Question about what we pay for security for events on campus. One example is the Men's Club pays two uniformed officers \$200 each for every event. We will want to be consistent with the pay.
 - Vicki will reach out to Bethany and Relevant to get information on their security.
 - Father suggested having Lt Gordon back as a resource to consult with the Security committee.
 - Goal is to have officers in place at Masses for Advent Season.
